

Wisconsin Acquisition Process Summary

Business Relocation

Acquisition Stage Relocation Plan

- Must be completed and approved by Wisconsin Department of Commerce between purchasing properties.
- Provides assurances that agency is implementing relocation program correctly.
- Provides an estimate of relocation costs
- Involves meeting with each occupant

Acquisition:

- Complete appraisals
- Present offer to owner
- Allow for Statute required 60 day period for owner's appraisal
- Negotiate an agreement
- Conduct closing

Relocation:

- Provide relocation eligibilities to occupants <u>after the offer to purchase</u> is made
 - Replacement Business Payment
 - Maximum \$30,000 for tenants / \$50,000 for owners
 - Calculated from currently available comparable properties
 - Moving costs
 - Actual Reasonable Cost plus Reestablishment Payment
 - Fix Payment-in-lieu (maximum \$20,000)
- Occupants can move at any time after the offer to purchase is made.
- If occupants move before the property is purchased, owner is eligible for rent loss.
- Assist occupants with finding replacement property.
- > Assist occupants with relocation reimbursement process.
